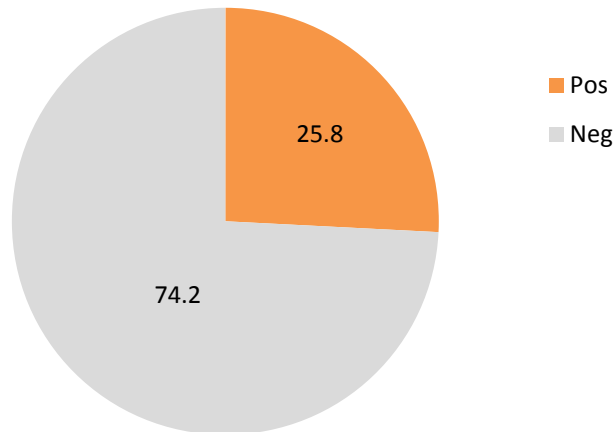


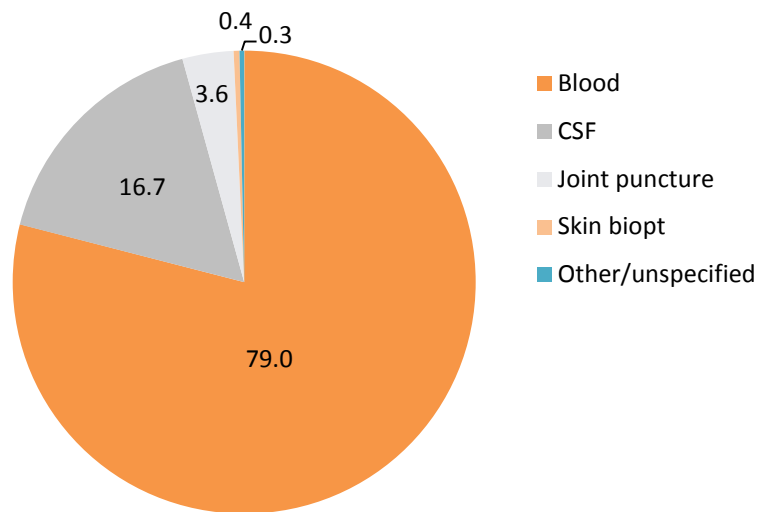
## Borrelia sp, data=2013, NRC

The 637 positive results correspond to 566 individuals.

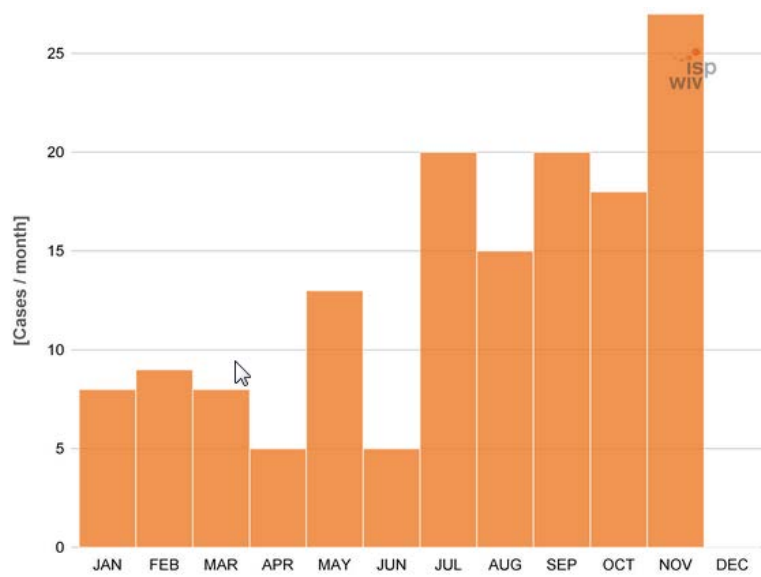
Type of specimen sent for diagnostic in percentage (n=2468)



Positivity rate by specimen and by type of test

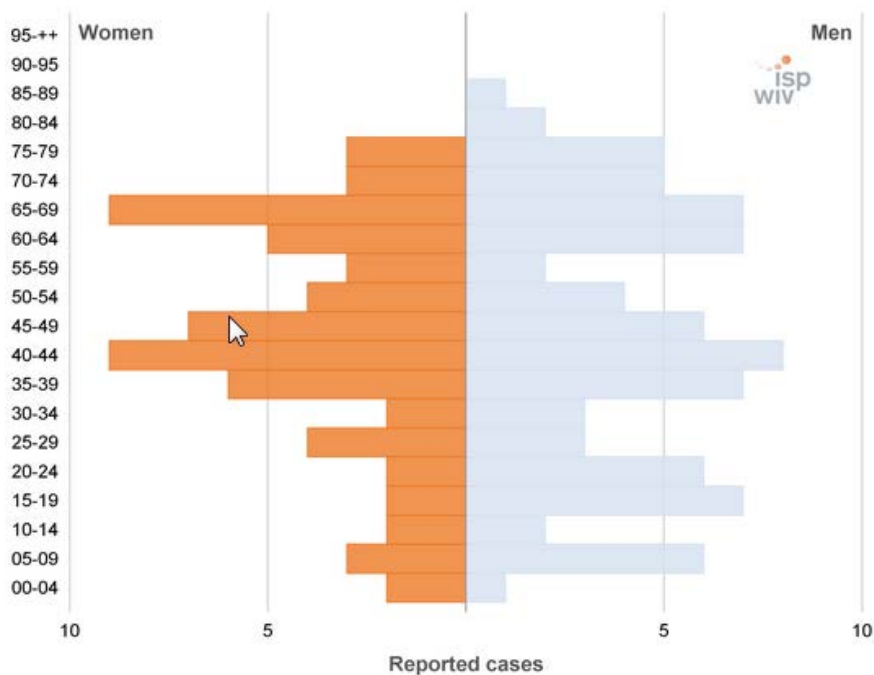

### Monthly distribution (n=148), temporary results



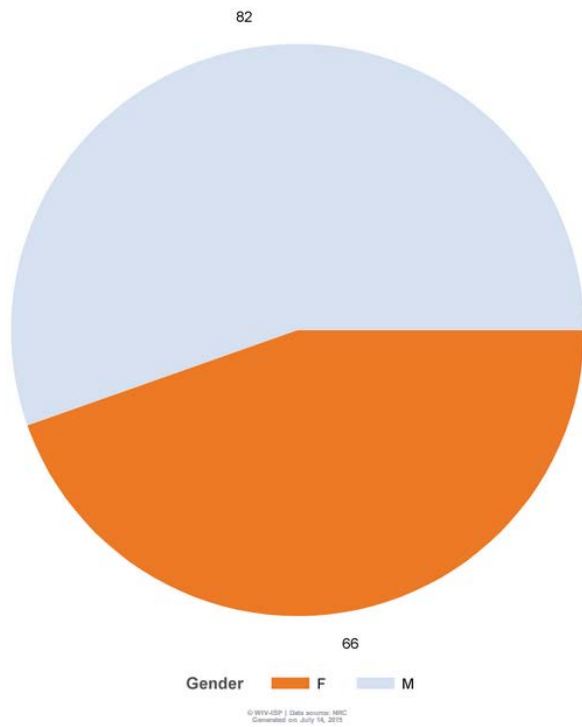

### Age distribution of patients (n=148), temporary results

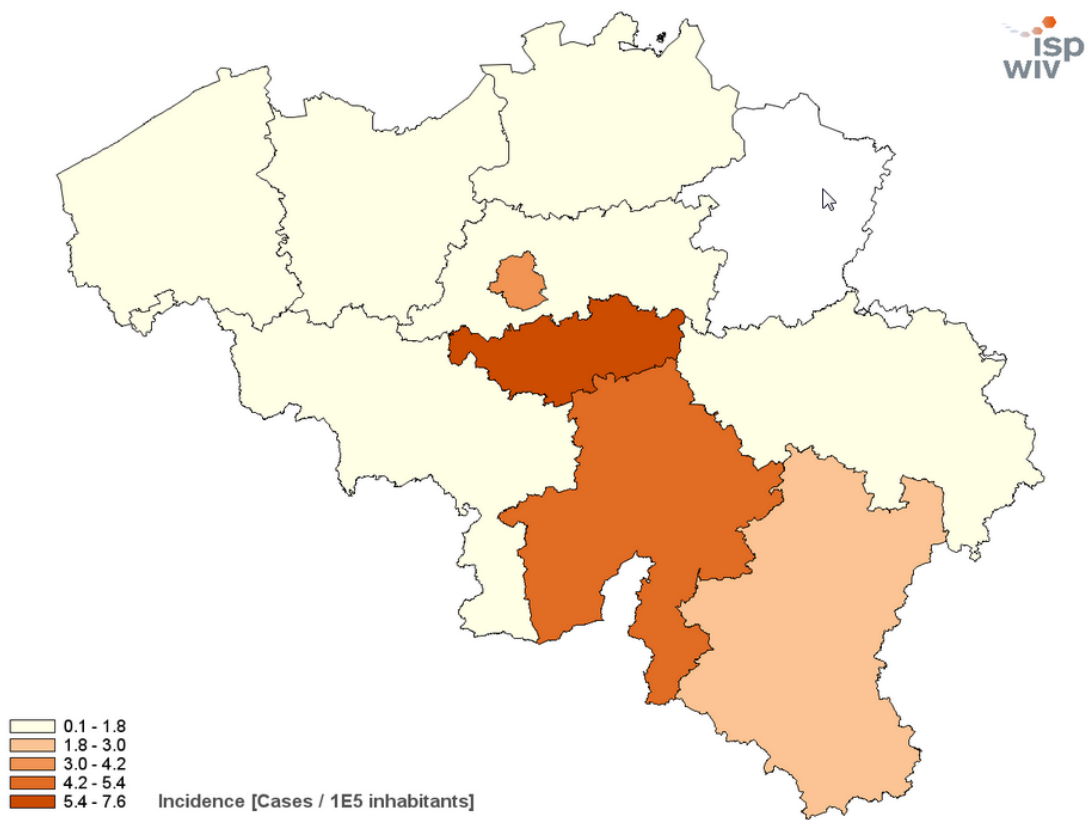

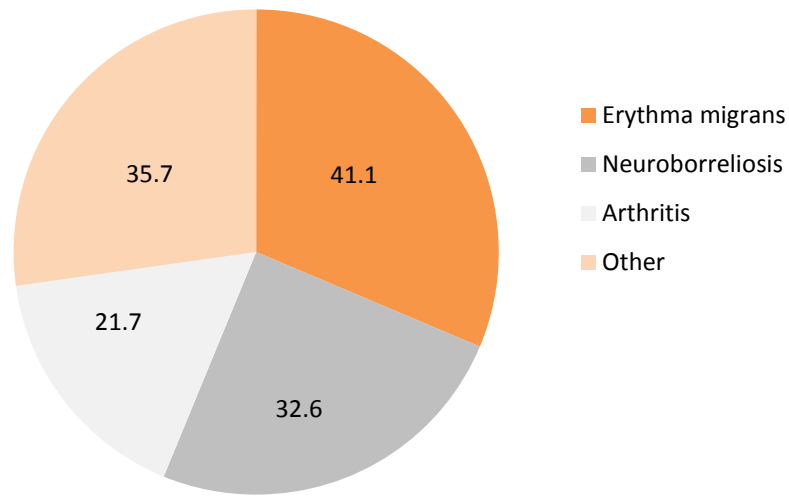
### Gender distribution of patients (n=148), temporary results



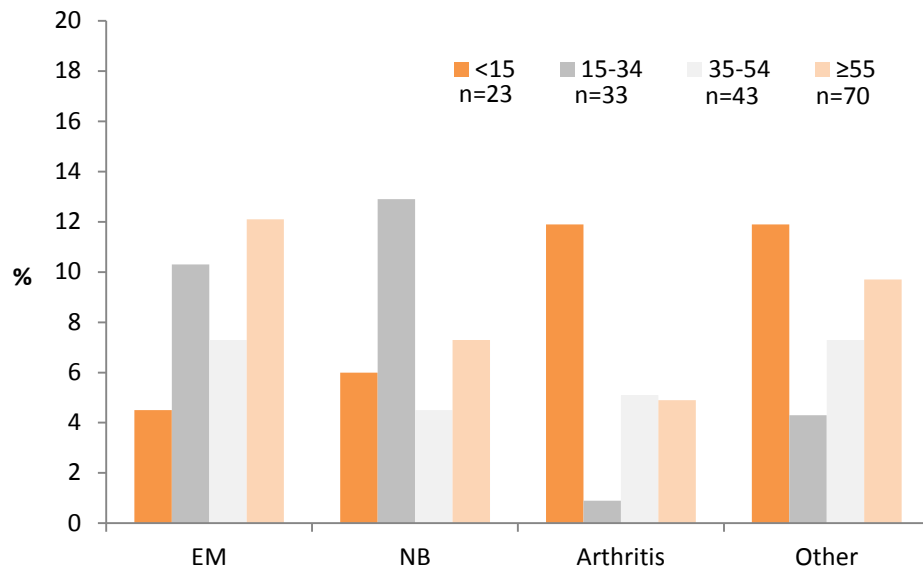
### Geographical distribution of samples received by the NRC, (n=148), temporary results



**Clinical presentation in % (n=169, 30% of positives)**



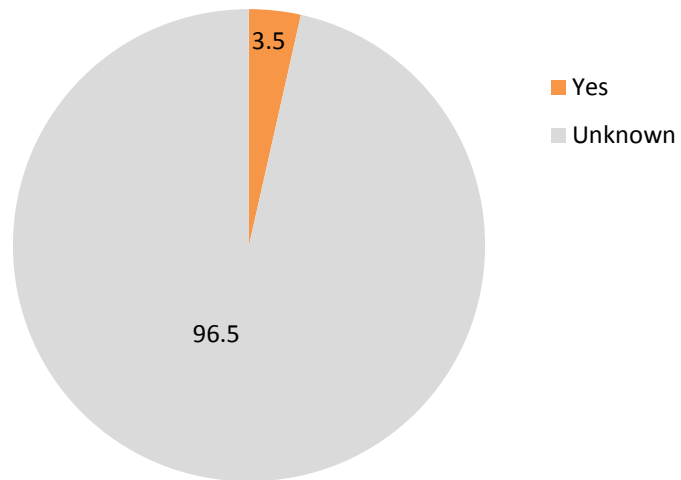
**Clinical presentation by age group (n=169)**
